- **THERE WILL ONLY BE RATINGS POSTED THIS YEAR.** Here is an example:

Actual tally scores will determine finalists. They will be announced at approximately 6:30 PM.

- **IN CASE OF A TIE:** We will throw out the highest and lowest score and end up with a score in the middle. This will eliminate the tie. If this still does not correct the problem we will have the judges decide!

Example: Band #1 receives 853, 932, 868 TOTAL:2653 (*Throw out the high & low and end up with 868*)
Band #2 receives 844, 903, 906 TOTAL:2653 (*Throw out the high & low and end up with 903*)

EACH BAND WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO PLAY THREE (3) SONGS TOTAL DURING THEIR REGULAR DAY PERFORMANCE. YOU WILL ONLY HAVE 20 MINUTES TO SET-UP AND PLAY. We need five (5) minutes to give out solo awards at the end of your performance. We must keep the performance schedule on time!

You have only 20 minutes total to set-up and perform! Please plan accordingly!

If you do not comply, you will be asked to leave the stage in the middle of a song without hesitation. If this still does not stop your performance it will be your last appearance at the Folsom Jazz Festival.

Finals Competition:

- **NOTE: All High School Big Bands - you'll start your set with a sight-reading piece given to you on stage. You'll have 5 minutes to brief the tune - no singing or clapping allowed. You will then play a song of your choice. Please play one (1) song that will only take five (5) minutes to play!**
- Any band not adhering to these rules will be asked to leave the stage and be disqualified!
- The order of finalist groups will be determined by drawing names from a hat. Done by scorers.
- The two Jazz Choir finalists will be posted by 6:00 PM so they are ready to go at approximately 7:00 PM
- **All Jazz Choirs & M.S. Band Finalists will play two (2) songs that take ten (10) min. total & there is no sight-reading. ONE TUNE MUST BE DIFFERENT THAN THE DAYS SET!**

Note: If your application was sent in among the last 20 groups accepted, your division grouping may not reflect your actual school size. We tried to fill out all four divisions to be equal in size.

Turn Right at White Rock Road. RHCC is on the left.

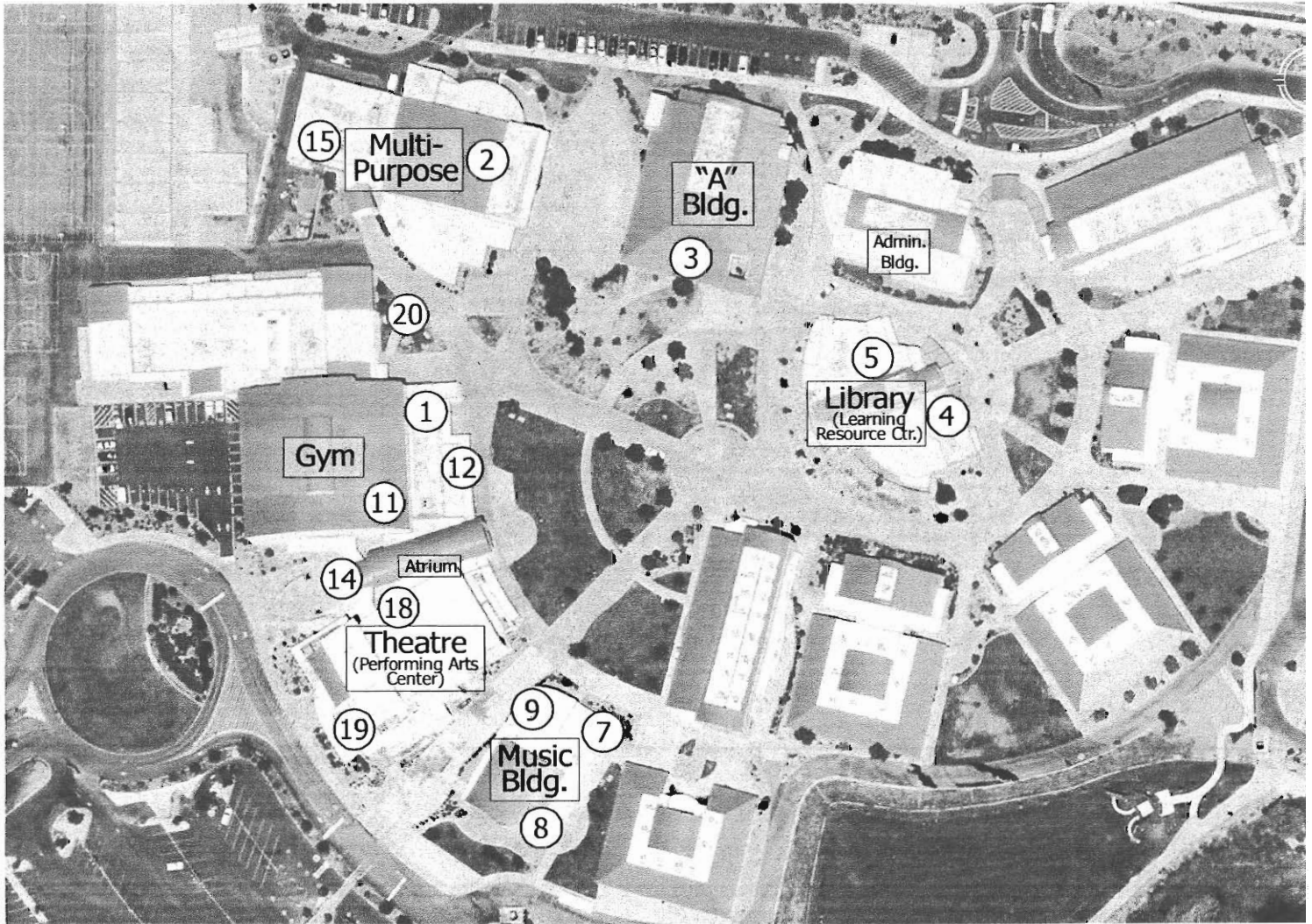

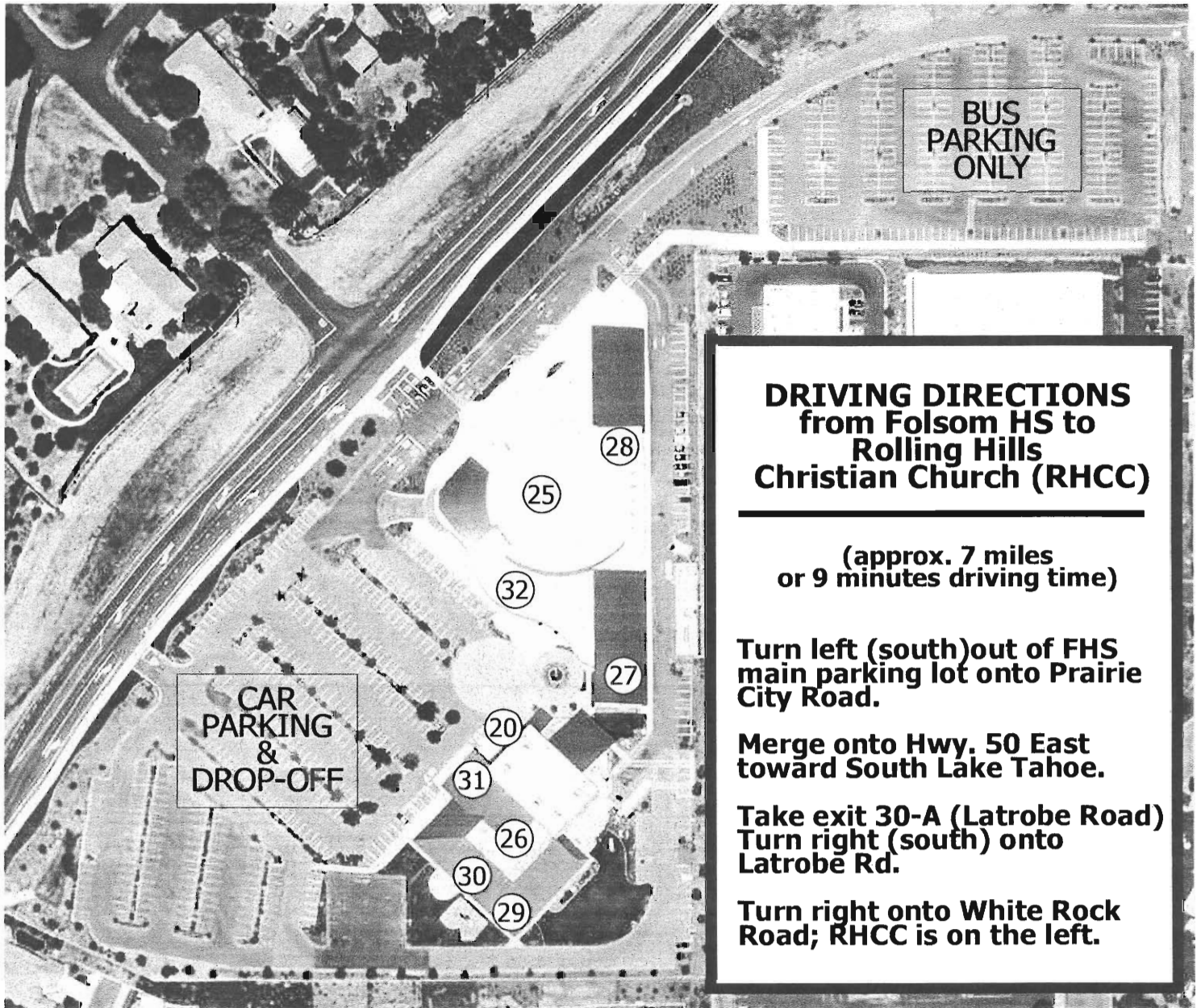

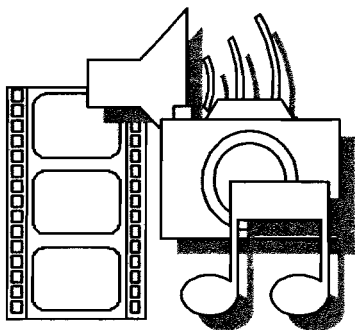
